How to access free dental care

Smile Squad dental packs

All children deserve a healthy smile, and the Smile Squad free school dental program is working hard to dental pack contains a toothbrush, full sized toothpaste, and an oral health brochure. Please take the help make sure this happens. Your child(ren) will soon receive a free dental pack to bring home. The time to read the brochure. It's full of helpful hints and tips to help your whole family eat well, drink well and clean well – for life. Smile Squad provides standard strength fluoride toothpaste that is generally used by ages six and over, unless recommended by a dental or trained health professional.

If your child is under six, please talk to a dental or trained health professional to find out if your child might benefit from using this toothpaste. You can also choose to put the toothpaste away until they turn six or give it to someone else in your family to use.

Do I need to attend my child's appointment?

No, you do not need to attend your child's appointment. You can attend if you would like to, and you can take your child to the community dental clinic if you prefer.
