After being away last term, it's been terrific to reconnect with students, staff and parents over the past couple of weeks. A big thank you to Mr Lehane and the entire staff team for doing a terrific job throughout Term 3.

Term 4 is always a busy one and as can be seen in the 'Dates to Remember' we already have some fantastic programs locked in for the students, including Bike Ed for our Gr 3/4/5/6s, the Little Learners Program for our 2024 Preps, the Gr 5/6 Canberra Camp, P/1/2 Sleepover at School and the Swimming Program. We're also finalising arrangements for the Grade 6 Graduation and the End-of-Year Concert and will be able to confirm details for these in the coming weeks.

I am pleased to report that these works have been successful and that the students and staff have enjoyed using the Outdoor Learning Space over the first couple of weeks of Term.

This week our Grade 3/4/5/6 students began Bike Education and have been learning a range of bicycle and road safety skills. These have included how to effectively use brakes, where to position the bike for safe riding on the road and signalling when turning or stopping.
